- It is hoped to re-start having a home Mass each month in conjunction with the Pilgrim Statue & blessing of people's homes to start on February 2024.
- Earlier in the year, Sr. Nola Delf (one of our Auxiliaries) initiated contact with Mark Browning, headmaster of Mary McKillop who agreed to allow the Legion to give 2 weekly lessons to all Year 3 Classes on the Rosary.
- We are going to have a busy bee to make some Rosaries to be given out over Christmas. We have been collecting beads and any sources are welcome.
- We are always trying to get more auxiliaries who are back-up prayer warriors to support and keep our active members going. This year we have obtained commitment from 4 people to become Auxiliaries.
